100% Beds in Government Hospitals treating COVID 19 and 50% Beds in all Private Hospitals of Bangalore treating COVID 19 which are empaneled with Suvarna Arogya Suraksha Trust (SAST) are open for admission under the BBMP Quota.

### Patient Condition:

1. If any patient has tested negative in the RT-PCR test but has lung infection in Chest CT Scan, this case is a **SARI**[Severe Acute Respiratory Infections] case. You will have to mention this on call when you attempt for a bed through the BBMP helplines and any other helpline.
2. If the patient has tested positive but only has SRF number but does not have BU number, get that information from the link to find BU number.
3. If patient has SRF and BU number, move straight to Step 3

## How to Block a BED under BBMP Quota in a Govt / Private Hospital in Bangalore?

Step 1 : Check the Latest Status on Availability of beds under BBMP Quota

Step 2 : Keep SRF ID & BU Number ready

SRF ID is a 13 digit no. given to every person who takes up RAT Test or RTPCR Test. The SRF ID comes to the registered mobile no. of the person after sample is collected and is also printed in the Test Report.

BU number is a 6 digit unique number generated by BBMP. It's generated only for patients who test positive for COVID19. The Govt / private lab must upload the details of the test in ICMR portal and only then BU number is generated. Please ensure the testing centre has uploaded your Test Report on ICMR Portal, else BU number will not be generated.

Generally BU number comes as an SMS. However, if you do not get BU number by SMS, click on this link to get your BU number

Step 3 : If you have SRF ID & BU Number Ready, **Call 1912 or 108 or 080- 23010101/ 02**
